Core Principles of Home Learning

Article 30: "Education must develop every child's personality, talents and abilities to the full."

Context

To encourage the children to develop, apply and extend the skills they have learnt in school in a fun and interactive way. Also to involve parents / carers in their child's learning by encouraging them to use and consolidate their new skills, whilst developing a curiosity about the world.

Core Principles

Motivating – engages the children through a variety of tasks linked to their interests and curiosity

Meaningful – purposeful tasks linked to learning which supports and challenges learning.

Involves Parents – Supportive and engaging tasks that help inform parents / carers of how to support their child's learning.

Variety - Variety of activities that meets the needs of all children and their learning styles, including focused and some open ended activities.

Manageable - Quality rather than quantity, with activities that promote speaking and listening, family involvement and celebrate their child's achievements.
