F2 and Pre School: Hot Chocolate/ Biscuits/ Pot Noodles (Chicken & mushroom or curry are favourites)

Year 1: Tinned sausage & beans/ curry/ meatballs/ spaghetti bolognese/soup

Year 2: Toiletries eg Soap/ shower gel/ shampoo/ toothpaste & toothbrushes/ shaving foam/ deodorant

Wednesday 4th October: Miss Owen's (St David) Class assembly (Harvest Celebration) at 9.00am – parents/carers are welcome to attend (2 per family only please)
