# Arrival at School

Just a reminder that school starts promptly at 8.45, School finishes at 3.15pm.

May I also take this opportunity to remind you that at the end of the day, children will only be allowed to leave with the named person. Any changes to this must be in writing and only by telephone in an emergency.

# <u>Absences</u>

It is very important that if your child is absent from school, a telephone call must be made to the school (a message can be left on the separate attendance answer phone or via Parent Mail). We need to know the reason for all absences.

If you are late, you must enter the school via the main entrance and sign the Late Book. I am sure that we can count on your assistance in this matter.

# Holidays in Term Time

Following Government regulations for Holidays in Term Time, I am just reminding you that the Governors will not grant any holidays requested in term time. Please be aware that any unauthorised holidays will be subject to a Fixed Penalty Notice Fine.

Should you need to request a leave of absence for exceptional circumstances, an "Application for Leave during term time" form must be completed and sent in to Mrs Bulmer at least 2 weeks before the proposed leave, stating the reasons for the request. This will then be considered by the Governors.

# School Uniform

The children are looking very smart in their new uniforms and your support in this area is greatly appreciated. <u>Please</u> <u>do ensure that all uniform is clearly marked with your</u> <u>child's name.</u>

May I also remind you that sensible flat (black) shoes are essential for health and safety reasons. <u>Boots/trainers</u> are <u>not</u> permitted as we wish to maintain a smart appearance.

The wearing of <u>jewellery</u> is <u>not</u> permitted in school. This includes <u>earrings</u>, <u>watches and necklaces</u>. <u>Nail varnish and tattoos</u> are also not allowed.

Please be advised that any child wearing earrings to school will be asked to remove them. If you are considering having your child's ears pierced, please wait until the beginning of the summer holidays to allow them sufficient time to heal before returning to school. If your child has had their ears pierced and require earrings to be worn, a letter must be sent in to Mrs Bulmer informing her of when they were pierced. They must wear plasters/ micropore tape over the earrings throughout the day until they can be removed. Once the six weeks period has passed, the earrings must be removed and not worn to school.

Extreme hairstyles/ haircuts, e.g. <u>shaven heads</u>, <u>part</u> <u>shaven/patterned heads or Mohicans/spiky hair</u> are not allowed, as they are inappropriate for young school children.

**Big multi-coloured bows** are also not allowed to be worn in school. Hair accessories should be kept to the minimum and in the school colours only.

# PE Kit

White t-shirts, navy blue shorts and black pumps are required for PE. During the winter months a pair of jog pants can be brought in as well, as we still have PE sessions outside. It also assists staff if children's names are on their PE clothing and bags. PE begins this week and all kits should be in school.

#### Medicines and Inhalers

Prescription medicine will only be administered in school if absolutely necessary (i.e. medicine prescribed to be taken <u>4 times per day</u>). This is at the discretion of the Head teacher and parents will be required to complete a consent form giving all relevant information.

Inhalers needed by the children suffering from asthma are kept in the child's classroom in the safe keeping of the class teacher. Parents will be required to fill in a consent form indicating dosage/frequency.

It is also important to let us know of any changes to any allergies/medical requirements.

#### Pupil Premium Funding

Just a reminder that although all children receive a free school meal throughout their time at the Infant school, if you are in receipt of certain benefits and meet the qualifying conditions (visit:www.wirral.gov.uk/freeschool-meals), the school is entitled to <u>Pupil Premium</u> <u>Money</u> for each child registered. This money is used to provide your child with additional 1 on 1 or small group sessions dependent on their learning needs. All school trips will also be free of charge for your child. If you don't register, our school will miss out on this much needed and valuable funding. More information is available from the school office.

#### Milk Provision

Our milk provider is "Cool Milk". If you would like your child to have milk during the day, please register on line at www.coolmilk.com. <u>Please note that if you</u> are in receipt of certain benefits and have the extra pupil premium funding in school, you will be entitled to Free Milk. You will still need to register with Coolmilk to get your free milk.

#### Healthy School

As you are aware, we are a Health Promoting School, so I would ask parents not to send sweets/cakes into school for the classes on their birthdays. Your cooperation in this matter would be greatly appreciated. We also have a strict No Smoking policy in the school which includes the grounds and outside the school gates—this also applies to the use of e/vapour cigarettes.

#### Mobile Phone Use

For the safety of the children, the use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited within the school building. All phones must be switched off when entering the building. Thank you for your co-operation.

Our E-Safety & Online policy can be accessed on our website in the Key Information section along with all the other main policies for the school.

#### School Website and Twitter (now known as "X")

Please don't forget to visit our website for the latest copies of newsletters/ Weekly Briefings and announcements. We are continually updating the site with copies of important school policies, documents and school information. The school Office Twitter feed can also be accessed from the front page of the website There are individual Class Twitter Feeds and these can be accessed via our website under Class Feeds in the main menu —just look for your class teacher's name.

The Twitter Feeds will be the place to see photos and information about what's going on in your child's classroom and in school generally There will be posts every week and they are kept constantly updated. Keep a look out!!

Please be reassured that we will not use any photographs of your children until you give us permission. We have a list of all those children that you have given consent for their images to be used on twitter, our website and around the school. Consent to using your child's images will last throughout your child's time at the school. You can however, change or withdraw your consent at any time by contacting the school.
