The Magic Paintbrush

This topic will use the fiction text The Magic Paintbrush by Julia Donaldson, as a stimulus. The Magic Paintbrush retells an old Chinese folk story based on kindness and selfless acts. In Geography, the children will compare and contrast Wirral with Hong Kong in China, using their physical and human geographical skills. They will use globes, atlases and virtual tours to help gain a greater in-depth knowledge. In our science lessons, the children will have the opportunity to explore growing comparing bulbs and seeds. They will use these to grow plants and observe changes. In Art the children will explore the medium of sculpture using the Terracotta Army for inspiration and learn about other famous sculptors. They will use their ideas to create their own Chinese mask. Finally, in Computing, the children will investigate thecommon uses of information technology beyond school using the iPad. As part of our Faith Learning Journey, we will visit The Metropolitan Cathedral in Liverpool to look at feature . Catholic Social Teaching we will be learning about Stewardship and in RSE looking at how God created us to love others.
