The story book Funny Bones will be the inspiration for this topic about their amazing human body. They will learn how to name and describe body parts, including their bones. They will carry out scientific test to investigate their senses and how they help them to make sense of the world around them. Using i-pads they will capture movement using video and still photographs, and try adding sound to moving pictures. The theme of movement will be used to help them explore how to make a moving picture of the body through using split pins. Finally, they will investigate how they have changed since they were born. What toys have they played with but don't any more? Why have they changed? How have they changed? The Option for The Poor and Vulnerable of Catholic Social Teaching will be addressed by reflecting on how some people don't have good houses, food or water and we need to show extra care to them.
