
Year 1 Spring Term 2 Feb - March

The Adventure Of The Green Ship



The focus of this topic will come from the book The Green Ship by Quentin Blake. In the story two children take an imaginary journey around the world. This will provide the opportunity to look at different countries around the world and compare hot and cold places. They will use maps and atlases to locate the countries of the United Kingdom, name some towns and cities, and learn about the four compass points. In the places they visit they will learn how to draw different animals and explore ways to print animal patterns. This will then lead into naming, describing and comparing a range of animals and being able to classify them into carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. Then they will choose an animal to create an information sheet about on the APP Pic Collage. The Stewardship of Catholic Social Teaching will be addressed by reflecting on how God made all animals and we have a duty to care and look after them.
