The Lighthouse Keeper

Year 2

Summer Term 1 April - May

This topic will use the story books The Lighthouse Keeper as a stimulus. The children will explore how to paint seascapes using paint and add tint and tone. Building on from this they will make a painting of a lighthouse and seascape, and add collage yachts using matchsticks and tissue paper. In DT the children will learn how to make a wooden picture frame by measuring and cutting / sawing wood. They will add features to strengthen the structure, then add finishing touches to their design. They will use the frame to house their own picture. The theme of the seaside will be developed by investigating what seaside holidays were like in the past. They will question family members about their memories and look at Edwardian seaside holidays. We will also be learning about a famous figure in history, Grace Darling. Our science strand will be based on habitats and mini-beasts in the school grounds. In Jigsaw (PSHE) the children will be learning about relationships. Our RSE topic is Created to live in Community and our Catholic Social Teaching will be based on Solidarity.
