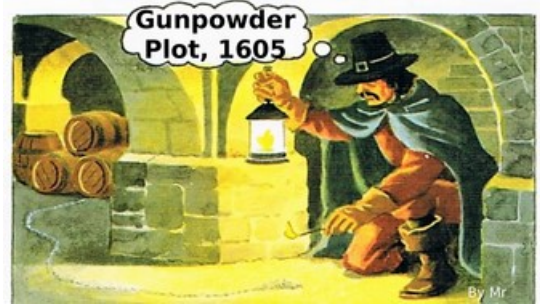


Year 1 Autumn Term 2 Nov - Dec

Being Famous!



The theme for this topic will be exploring famous people and the achievements or events that happened in their lives. The children will investigate why we have Bonfire Night and learn about the events of the Gunpowder Plot and Guy Fawkes. This will lead into thinking about our Royal family today, who they are and what they do. The theme of being famous will extend to visiting the Lady Lever Art Gallery to explore famous paintings and artists. The children will take inspiration from the visit, to explore mixing primary colours to make secondary colours and create their own paintings using different brush sizes. Then, taking their ideas from this they will explore painting APPs to create digital images, selecting tools and altering their size. They will explore famous British Artists and try to copy and use their style as they create their own painting. The Dignity of the Human Person of Catholic Social Teaching will be addressed by reflecting on how God created each of us to be unique and the importance of treating each other in a caring way. The children will continue on their 'My Happy Minds' journey, learning how to have a healthy mind.
